The Board is in receipt of an Application for a Certificate of Appropriateness, marked received January 24, 2019, requesting permission to extend the display of the Dennis Oppenheim's Straight Red Trees, 2006. Ms. Strassfield appeared to answer any questions.

3. **Audemas Piguet – Premises of Smithie, LLC – 20 Main Street – SCTM #301-3-5-16**

The Board is in receipt of a letter from Daniel Grgorinic dated January 21, 2019 requesting permission to strip the black paint from the formed bronze façade

and to leave it to weather. Mr. Villano appeared on behalf of the applicant and stated that the existing black façade will fade over time which is why there is a request to remove the paint; the shiny finish of the bronze, after the paint is removed, will tarnish. Mr. Hefner found no objection.

Upon motion of Robert D. Caruso, duly seconded by Kristin Corwin, the Board unanimously approved the request.
